Program participants should plan to bring their own bedding, personal items, and towels.

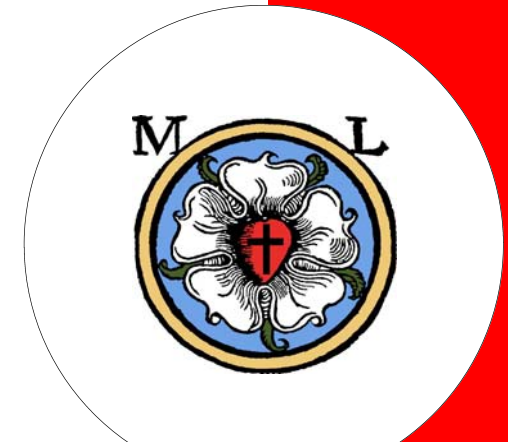

How to make the most of your retreat.

Our retreats are designed for individual congregations or for circuits. Often an entire circuit will decide to do a joint retreat with pastors and students from all or most of the congregations in a circuit. Pastors may then specialize in particular topics that can be presented to all of the students. This type of circuit retreat provides young people with the opportunity to get to know youth from other congregations they may get to know through ACT in future years.

When you've decided when you want to have

your retreat, give us a call. We'll visit with you about your goals and any special activities you might want. We encourage you to bring along an adequate number of adult chaperones as the camp does not provide in-house supervision. A ratio of 1 adult for each 10 students is helpful, but not necessary. We have room for up to 70 participants each weekend and some weekends we can also make use of our Retreat House and Martha Cabin.

It is a good idea to schedule your retreat as soon as possible to assure you the best selection of dates.
